

**TOWN OF HAVERHILL**  
**HURRICANE MILTON – UPDATE #2**  
**OCTOBER 8, 2024 @ 2:30 P.M.**

Hurricane Milton is projected to make landfall on the west coast of Florida on Wednesday, with impacts to Palm Beach County.

The Town of Haverhill Town Hall will be open during normal business hours until further notice.

Waste Pro is in the process of picking up garbage and recycling today, and vegetation pickup will be proceeding on Wednesday as usual.

All hurricane preparations should be completed by now. If not already done, remember to bring all loose items indoors so they don't become projectiles in the storm.

Palm Beach County services will be closed beginning at Noon on Wednesday, with the exception of emergency services. The County's public safety website has important information regarding shelters that will be opening, flood zones, how to prepare for a hurricane, and more. In addition, the Palm Beach County emergency information line is open. Questions related to this hurricane may be answered by calling 561-712-6400.

As a reminder, it is expected that streets, sidewalks, driveways and lawns may temporarily flood depending on volume and duration of rainfall. These areas are designed to act as secondary detention areas. This flooding is temporary and will begin to recede after the event has passed. Stay indoors during severe storm events. Do not attempt to walk or drive in flooded areas. Flood water may be unsanitary and there may be downed power lines or other hazards that are not visible.

Stay safe and please keep an eye on weather updates from reliable sources.
