The regular monthly meeting of the Haverhill Town Council was held on Thursday, October 27, 2016 at the Town Hall, 4585 Charlotte Street, Haverhill, Florida. Those present were Jay G. Foy, Mayor; Lawrence Gordon, Vice Mayor; Mark C. Uptegraph, Council Member; Jo H. Plyler, Council Member and Remar M. Harvin, Council Member. Also present were Lance Fuchs, Town Attorney; Janice C. Rutan, Town Administrator and Joseph Roche, Director of Public Services.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Foy called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Foy offered the Invocation and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL

The Town Administrator called the roll. All members were present with the exception of Council Member Gordon.

(Council Member Plyler excused herself from the dais because of an emergency call).

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Janet Long, Bill Rowan, 4910 Luwal Drive: Ms. Long and Mr. Rowan addressed the Town Council and offered the idea that the Council consider reappointing members to the Beautification Committee. The Beautification Committee was responsible for recommending the "House of the Month" to Council for recognition of homes that were well maintained and beautifully landscaped.

Discussion followed and it was agreed that Council would discuss the subject at their November 1, 2016 workshop and if all agreed the committee should be reinstated, they would make appointments at their November meeting.

COMMENTS FROM THE PALM BEACH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

Captain Patrick Johnson, District 1 Commander, was present representing the Palm Beach County Sheriff's office. He reported that during the previous 2 week period, there had been an incident in the Haverhill Park involving marijuana.

Discussion followed. Mayor Foy questioned if the approval of medical marijuana had effected protocol within the PBSO as it related to possession of marijuana.

Council Member Harvin noted that he had served on the Palm Beach County's Criminal Justice Committee and how the "Officers Next Door" program was instrumental in making neighborhoods safer using incentives for officers to move into certain neighborhoods.

Council expressed their appreciation to the Sheriff's Department with all agreeing that the additional funding set aside each year in the budget kept the Town of Haverhill a safe neighborhood.


