Town Hall Council Chambers Thursday ~ July 23, 2015 OFFICIAL MINUTES

Pursuant to the foregoing notice, the regular meeting of the Haverhill Town Council was held on Thursday, July 23, 2015 at the Town Hall, 4585 Charlotte Street, Haverhill immediately following the close of the Local Planning Agency Meeting. Those present were Jay G. Foy, Mayor; Jerry Beavers, Council Member; Lawrence Gordon, Council Member and Mark C. Uptegraph, Council Member. Vice Mayor Woods participated via telephone. Also present were Town Attorney John Foster, Director of Public Services Joseph Roche and Town Administrator, Janice C. Rutan.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Foy called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Foy offered the Invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance at the previous meeting.

ROLL CALL

The Town Administrator recorded all members present, but noted for the record that Vice Mayor Woods was participating via telephone.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

None.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

There being no additions, deletions or substitutions, the agenda stood as presented.

APPROVAL OF THE CONSENT AGENDA

Approval of the minutes for the and June 25, 2015 and July 9, 2015 regular meetings A motion was made Council Member Uptegraph, seconded by Council Member Gordon and unanimously passed (5-0) to approve the consent agenda as presented.

PROCLAMATIONS AND PRESENTATION

Proclamation in recognition of Jeff Renault, Town Engineer, for years of service to the Town of Haverhill

(Mayor Foy requested this matter be addressed after the public hearing).

COMMENTS FROM THE PALM BEACH COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPT.

Deputy Strickland was present and presented the crime statistics for the previous 2 week period. He reported that there had been a break in to trailers parked at the Jehovah Witness's construction site and tools had been stolen. Discussion followed and it was suggested that the crime could have been an inside job, as they knew exactly which trailers to break into.

There had been routine traffic stops. Again it was mentioned that residents to be sure to keep their homes and their vehicles locked at all times.

The Council expressed their appreciation to PBSO for the permit detail within the Town.

SECOND READINGS AND PUBLIC HEARINGS

The title was read by Attorney Foster.

Mayor Foy opened the Public Hearing and noted for the record that he was recusing himself from discussion due to a business relationship his firm had with the applicant, DRHorton. He completed form 8b for filing in the permanent record.

Julian Bryan, applicant on behalf of DR Horton, addressed the Council. He noted that the legal description for the re-zoning would less out the north 25' and would remain zoned R-2.

James Bogaert, 4965 Club Road. Mr. Bogaert questioned the perpetual maintenance of the north 25'.

Attorney Foster responded that the maintenance of the north 25' would be the responsibility of the abutting property owners.

Discussion followed. It was explained that once the property transferred, the food bank being operated by the church would cease. Mr. Bogaert commented the property owners would grade the road at that point. It was confirmed that the north 25' when deeded to the property owners would transfer as a 15' swale with a 10' shellrock road.

A motion was then made by Council Member Gordon and seconded by Vice Mayor Woods to approve the adoption of Ordinance 430 on second reading with conditions of approval attached hereto and made a part thereof. The motion passed 4-0, with Mayor Foy recusing himself from the vote.

FIRST READINGS AND REGULAR AGENDA

Approve Site Plan for Haverhill Point as presented by D.R. Horton for property located on the southeast corner of Club Road (east) and Haverhill Road, parcel control number 22-42-43-36-00-000-3150

Vice Mayor Foy recused himself from discussion and completed form 8b for filing in the permanent record.

The proposed site plan to construct 24 single family homes was reviewed by the Town Council. Julian Bryan, on behalf of the applicant addressed the Town Council. He explained that all models were between 1500 sf and 2500 sf, had two car garages and would have asphalt shingled roofs.

He explained they were also requesting a variation from the minimum lot width and front setbacks to allow for staggered placement of the homes on the lots.

The site plan, home elevations and landscape plans would remain on file at the Town Hall for public review.

A motion was then made by Councilmember Gordon and seconded by Council Member Uptegraph to approve the site plan and request for variations, as submitted, dated 4/20/15 and received by the Town of Haverhill on July 15, 2015. The motion passed 4-0, with Mayor Foy recusing himself from the vote.

Attorney Foster reflected on the recent passing of the Town's Engineer, Jeffrey Renault. Mr. Foster noted that he has served as the Town Attorney since 1984, and his father before him, since 1952. For as far back as he can remember, Jeff Renault had served as the Town Engineer and he was a fine man, absent from conflict. He remembered working with Lucy Renault, Jeff's mother, the Town's first female Mayor on the own Charter. He commented that the town was blessed to have had Jeff Renault as their Town Engineer and it was his honor to recognize such a great man, and such a great engineer.

Council agreed and thanked Attorney Foster for his kind words.

Director of Public Services reported that he and a very close friend of Mr. Renault's would be organizing an annual memorial golf tournament in Mr. Renault's honor, with the proceeds of the event going to the Wounded Warrior Foundation, a favorite charity of Mr. Renault's.

Mayor Foy expressed his desire to pass a proclamation in honor of Jeff Renault and asked all Council Members and staff to research and share ideas to be included in the proclamation so that he can be properly recognized for all he had done for the Town, his contributions and fine character. He reminded all that Mr. Renault had grown up in the Town.

Your responsibilities under the law when faced with voting on a measure in which you have a conflict of interest will vary greatly depending on whether you hold an elective or appointive position. For this reason, please pay close attention to the instructions on this form before completing the reverse side and filing the form.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 112.3143, FLORIDA STATUTES

A person holding elective or appointive county, municipal, or other local public office MUST ABSTAIN from voting on a measure which inures to his or her special private gain or loss. Each elected or appointed local officer also is prohibited from knowingly voting on a measure which inures to the special gain or loss of a principal (other than a government agency) by whom he or she is retained (including the parent organization or subsidiary of a corporate principal by which he or she is retained); to the special private gain or loss of a relative; or to the special private gain or loss of a business associate. Commissioners of community redevelopment agencies under Sec. 163.356 or 163.357, F.S., and officers of independent special tax districts elected on a one-acre, one-vote basis are not prohibited from voting in that capacity.

For purposes of this law, a "relative" includes only the officer's father, mother, son, daughter, husband, wife, brother, sister, father-in-law, mother-in-law, son-in-law, and daughter-in-law. A "business associate" means any person or entity engaged in or carrying on a business enterprise with the officer as a partner, joint venturer, coowner of property, or corporate shareholder (where the shares of the corporation are not listed on any national or regional stock exchange).

In addition to abstaining from voting in the situations described above, you must disclose the conflict:

PRIOR TO THE VOTE BEING TAKEN by publicly stating to the assembly the nature of your interest in the measure on which you are abstaining from voting; and

WITHIN 15 DAYS AFTER THE VOTE OCCURS by completing and filing this form with the person responsible for recording the minutes of the meeting, who should incorporate the form in the minutes.

APPOINTED OFFICERS:

Although you must abstain from voting in the situations described above, you otherwise may participate in these matters. However, you must disclose the nature of the conflict before making any attempt to influence the decision, whether orally or in writing and whether made by you or at your direction.

IF YOU INTEND TO MAKE ANY ATTEMPT TO INFLUENCE THE DECISION PRIOR TO THE MEETING AT WHICH THE VOTE WILL BE TAKEN:

 You must complete and file this form (before making any attempt to influence the decision) with the person responsible for recording the minutes of the meeting, who will incorporate the form in the minutes. (Continued on other side)
